To protect the general public and the employees of the Penn Valley Fire District, **effective immediately, all Penn Valley Fire District Stations and the Administrative Office are closed to the public for non-emergency business for at least the next thirty (30) Days**, in compliance with federal and state guidelines to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 Corona Virus. We will continually monitor the situation and make appropriate changes as necessary.
